Fulani Village - 2014

Reaching the Unreached - West Africa

January, 2015



This is a remote Fulani village out in the bush of rural Africa. The Fulani are a tribe of traditional herdsman who move with their cattle across North Africa. They are predominately Muslim ad not very welcoming of outsiders. They have been given credit for being one of the main reasons that Islam has spread across North Africa and sunk its roots deeply into the culture and tradition of millions of people.



This is a girl that lives in that village. She is a teenager, growing up in a culture where her options will be limited. Her education will be minimal. And her exposure to the world outside her family and village will be nearly nonexistent. How will she hear about Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior? Who will tell her? The little yellow pouch she wears around her neck is a talisman from the local witch doctor that is supposed to protect her from danger and illness. How will she learn that there is a God who loves her and will provide for her now and throughout eternity?

This is Jacob and Alice. Jacob is one of the missionaries that has been trained and equipped to carry the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the people of his area. But, he doesn't know the language that the Fulani speak. Fortunately, his wife Alice does! God has given her the love for the Fulani, the desire to share the Gospel with them, and a bicycle that will allow her to travel the distance necessary to reach their village a couple times a week. Because of her witness to the village, many in the village are responding to the Good News of Jesus Christ! Jacob and Alice are making a difference! Reaching the Unreached - West Africa is making a difference! Your support is making a difference!

- We have been able to support 20 missionaries, preaching, teaching, and evangelizing in 20 different tribes, including the Fulani who are listed as an unreached people group!
- 11 of our missionaries are serving in Ghana!
- 8 of our missionaries are serving in Togo!
- We have 1 missionary serving in Cote d'Ivoire!
- Through their work over the last 14 years, we have been able to establish 171 churches in villages where the name of Jesus had not previously been spoken!
- These 20 missionaries are in the process of training 353 disciples for ministry in their villages!
- In 2014, 694 people came to Christ and were baptized!
- Total attendance in these 171 churches is over 7000 adults each week!
- Your support has helped to pay the salaries, medical expenses, fuel, and rent for these 20 missionaries and their families!
- In 2014, 14 bicycles and several goats were provided for the disciples!
- 5 motorcycles were purchased!

- 4 Proclaimers (MP3 players of the New Testament in the local language) were given to villages!
- We were also able to complete the building of 7 houses for the missionary homes, so that we do
 not have to continually pay rent! And we have started 2 more!
- 2 missionaries relocated to evangelize a new area! Their moving expenses were paid!
- 2 churches have now been started in Burkina Faso, with local disciples being trained!
- Disciples are also being trained in Benin with the prospect of new churches being established!
- We have been able to continue to support 2 excellent, experienced pastors who provide local oversight and mentoring for the missionaries! They provide assistance, supervision, and advice as problems arise!
- Because of your support, we have also been able to provide Social Security for the missionaries that helps to provide for their retirement, future, and security of their families!
