Because of your prayers that there are missionaries in the villages enabling the gospel to go forward. Perhaps you invested your hard earned money to support a man like Syriaque in some unknown village in the bush. He has brought many to the Lord. These believers may sit with you or greet you. It is no small thing that you prayed and gave to make possible for the Fulani, Sissala, Wala, Mamprusis, Kusala, Moba, Bissa, Fra Fra, Birifor, Casseena, Gorman-

che, Dagari, and Banjara to make Jesus their Lord.

A recent report from Elia in India. He gave a Proclaimer (MP3 player with the NT in the Banjara language) to a good disciple. This man and his wife have gone off to harvest sugar cane. This is a common practice to earn extra income. They migrate much like the wheat harvesters who begin in Texas and follow the harvest up to ND. The Banjara go in small groups with two to nine bullock drawn, wooden two wheeled carts. The sugar cane is cut with a machete and loaded by hand onto the carts, then driven to the factory. In the evening these workers and wives sit around a fire, prepare and eat a simple meal. Here is where our friend with the Proclaimer will shine. He will play 20 or 30 minutes of the NT while everyone sits around. They will hear and discuss the scripture. Hallelujah, a Banjara farmer who has an evangelistic heart and wants his co workers to hear the Bible. We thank you and God bless you for your heart for the lost; so tribal's with unfamiliar names will see eternity. This is so WONDERFUL.

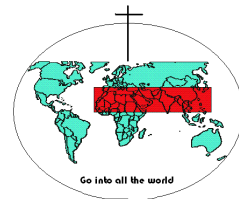

A word from Rodney

THANK YOU! THANK YOU! THANK YOU!

The day has come to make the transfer of RTUR to two leaders. Ps. Dan and Marji Cloeter for India and Ps. Tim and Bev Nappe for West Africa. I am enclosing envelope with this mailing so you may continue to support this work of planting churches in unreached areas.

Thank you! We do mean thank you because this work would not go forward without your help and your partnership. **We have been taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the unreached tribes in the 10-40 window. 98% of those who have never heard the Gospel of Jesus live in that window. Only 1% of the mission funds given from the USA goes to the 10-40 window. Yes, that is correct. Only 1% goes to this area of Muslims, Hindu's, Buddhist and animists that live 10 to 40 degrees north of the equator from west Africa to the Philippines. YOU ARE INVOLVED IN A UNIQUE WORK** reaching areas that have never heard. We began this work in 1991 by prayer. Then God said Go! Later we asked for help and you responded. We send our newsletters to 610 people. Only 170 of you contribute. I hope all of you pray. **YOU ARE SO NECESSARY FOR THIS WORK TO CONTINUE.**

I am enclosing an envelope and a piece of paper for you to email the new leaders to tell them you want to receive the India newsletter or the Africa newsletter or if you want both. Email would be the best avenue if you have an email. If you want it by mail there is an envelope enclosed to ask for it by mail. **PLEASE RESPOND TODAY!** Don't lay it aside and forget about it. You are important. We all must be involved in this important work. Eternity for the unreached depends on you being a part of this team.

Malinda and I will continue to pray. We will continue to give. We will even continue to go when opportunity comes. We will be glad to come to your church and share on missions if you ask us. It is time to pass the baton of this faithful work to new leadership while we are still in good health. TODAY IS THE DAY. Please make your response today also.

This morning we sang the hymn, ONWARD CHRISTIAN SOLDIERS, Marching as to war, With the Cross of Jesus, Going on before. Christ the royal Master, Leads against the foe; Forward into battle, See, his banners go! Onward, Christian soldiers, Marching as to war, With the Cross of Jesus, Going on before. In verse two we sang: At the sign of triumph, Satan's legions flee: On then, Christian soldiers, On to victory! Hell's foundations quiver, At the shout of praise; Brothers, lift your voices, Loud your anthem raise. Onward, Christian soldiers, Marching as to war, with the Cross of Jesus, Going on before. (Go ahead and sing it. Look up the rest of the verses)

We are so blessed and thankful as we have spent 21 years in mission work in these areas. We are thankful to meet you and work together as a team. The Lord has been blessing our mission endeavors in 2014. In Ghana, Togo and Cote D'Ivoire of West Africa, we have 20 missionaries preaching and making disciples in twenty tribes. They have established churches in a total of 171 villages that previously had no churches. These missionaries are training 353 disciples. They baptized 694 people this year. Total attendance for their churches is 7100 adult worshippers for Ghana and Togo that would not know Jesus without your help. You have paid salaries, medical, fuel and rent for these 20 men. In GHANA 14 bicycles were given for disciples. Five motorcycles were purchased and four Proclaimers (MP3 players with New Testament recorded in tribal language). We have six houses finished so we will not have to pay the increasing rent prices. We are building houses in two other places. We have spent \$22,180 on house building this year: \$10,680 in Ghana and \$11,500 in Togo. Two churches have been started in Burkina Faso to the north of Ghana. **IN TOGO YOU** have contributed 2 motorcycles for missionaries and 2 new motors to help disciples. Benches were given to begin a new church planting work in a new area in the East. Two missionaries and their families relocated to a new area forty miles SE to plant new churches. Moving costs were paid. **We also help support two excellent, mature supervisors** to help the missionaries with their problems and encourage and challenge them in their disciple making and church planting. Sadly, one missionary in Togo was killed in a motorcycle accident just 3 days before Christmas. We also pay Social Security for the missionaries and their families. We also helped with funeral expenses. **IN COTE D'IVOIRE** we have one missionary family and a new house has been finished.

In **INDIA** the 13 missionaries each know 112 Bible Stories. They teach in 500 tandas (villages) where they have established House Churches. You have paid salaries, fuel and medical. They have 170 disciples learning stories. There were 163 water baptisms this year. We support a sewing teacher and seven sewing machines were given to train Banjara girls in sewing. We had to restore our Jeep this year so that it would pass inspections for another five years. One bike was given to a disciple to reach others in their area. We praise God for the provisions. There are 6 million Banjara, (Gypsies) approximately 20,000 Banjara tandas who need to hear about Jesus Christ. Each tanda has 250-500 even up to a thousand people. God is abundantly growing this work. Jesus said, pray for laborers in the harvest field for the harvest is white. 13 Proclaimers were given so people in a tanda can hear the Gospel in their own Banjara language. These help new tandas to hear the Word of God.

The income received for 2014 is as follows: Total given \$176,639. We are so amazed. This is our best year ever. We rejoice in every dollar that is given and we use it in the wisest way possible. In 2014 we were able to send 3 men for animal husbandry training in Accra which they can pass on to the rest of the men to train the disciples how to care for goats and cattle so they can keep their animals alive and help the disciples become more self sufficient.
